

Greetings in Christ!

As we continue to navigate these uncharted waters of a Global Pandemic, we believe God helps us find ways to reach His people as never before. We pray for the day when we can join together without concern for social distancing. In the meantime, we will be continuing our commitment to the children of our church community and KREW will be going forward starting September 27<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 a.m. We will be continuing with “The Story” – lessons that show our children how we are all part of God’s plan for His People.

We will meet in the Lower Hall with the following procedures in place.

- DROP OFF: Temperature checks will be done on each person entering the building. Families will be asked to wait their turn (downstairs) and stay 6 ft. apart. Please bring as few people in the building as possible.
- COVID screening questions will be done by a nurse, Storm McNair, LPN
- After dropping off, parent/guardians are asked to leave the building
- Social distancing practices will be enforced during KREW time
- Cleaning practices will also be in place throughout the morning
- We will practice social distancing during dismissal – with one student being released at a time from their classroom. Kindly have your child(ren) dressed and out the door as quickly as possible
- Attendance will be taken for contact tracing purposes

We ask the following of you:

- Please bring the enclosed registration form (additional forms will be available)
- Please have your child bring their own “The Story” book from last year – Additional books will be available for those who never received one or who moved up a grade level.
- Older students are asked to bring their own Bible each Sunday
- Masks must be worn entering and exiting the building or if a child needs to leave the classroom area
- If your child has a fever of 100.4 or higher, or other signs of illness, they should not come to KREW
- Review proper hand washing and mask wearing techniques with your child and remind them that social distancing procedures will be in place
- If your child has a positive result for or has been exposed to someone with COVID-19, you are required to notify us. If there is a positive CASE of COVID-19 in the class or someone who has been exposed, all parents will be informed of that fact. No personal information will be shared.

Please continue to pray with our children for an end to this pandemic.
